"I like to make people feel good when they look at my paintings. For me, it's colour that does it every time, to make a painting resonate, you have to understand colour. Mine is very basic and I'm still learning. I was taught that colour is a language with its own psychology and vibrations and to observe the shades nature puts together when you are looking for inspiration. Nature is so powerful, it stills your centre and is very inspiring. Colour is very healing and energising."



MARILYN BROWNING

"Scraps of memory come and go, one thought enlarges another, they appear random, unrelated, until suddenly and stunningly, they don't. Freud referred to the unconscious as opportunist, and in this sense painting can be understood as watching and waiting. Sometimes during the still, concentrated observation of ordinary objects partial memories and vague feelings begin to surface, and the lifelessness of these inanimate subjects becomes endowed with enough presence to be felt."



JACQUELINE LEIGHTON BOYCE

"I draw inspiration from the immediate Exmoor landscape rather than research. My work is uncomplicated and I wish it to simply portray my love for this particular environment. It is personal and solitary and displays a simple and sometimes romantic narrative taken from regularly walking on Exmoor. It is important to me that viewers know that my ceramics are very definitely made from clay. I want to demonstrate a rawness and immediacy. In short, I like the clay to show itself."
